



Triumph Over Adversity: A Young Student's Journey from Hardship to Hope

A 12 year diligent student, who has just completed Class VI at Pachapalayam Government School, has faced numerous challenges. Coming from a family where his elder brother 14 years old who underwent surgery for Brain Tumour and is bedridden due to lower limb paralysis and blindness. His mother struggles to care for both children. This tough situation is further worsened by the absence of their father, who is an alcoholic and provides no support.

Despite these hardships, his story took a positive turn, thanking the compassionate efforts of the Coimbatore Cancer Foundation. Understanding the family's dire situation, a recommendation letter was given to **PSG Kanya Gurukulam Higher Secondary School, Coimbatore** to secure his education and accommodation at 'Manavar Illam' for Grade 7, all free of cost.

Now he is an inspiring example of how timely intervention and community support can make a substantial difference in a child's life. Despite facing numerous challenges at home, now he got an opportunity to pursue his education and aim for a brighter future. Collaboration with Community Health Centers

On June 6th, the Aravanaippu team visited the Kangayampalayam Health Sub Centre. During this visit, the team had a productive meeting with Dr. Yasodha, a practitioner of Siddha medicine, and Mrs. Chandralekha, the Village Health Nurse. The primary focus of the discussion was the activities of the Coimbatore Cancer Foundation (CCF) initiative and the rural home-based palliative care services offered by the CCF - Aravanaippu team. The collaboration aims to ensure that patients receive holistic care that addresses both medical and supportive needs within their homes and communities.
